This Month's By-Law

This column features one or two PTHC By-Laws.

ARTICLE V

ELECTIONS

The Board makes a copy of the PTHC By-Laws available at each meeting.

Section 1.

A nomination committee of three active members shall be appointed at the Board meeting in October. They shall report at the regular meeting in November.

Section 2.

Nomination may be made from the floor prior to election at the November meeting.

Section 3.

A majority vote, by ballot, shall elect. In the case of one nominee the Chair may declare the nominee elected.

Section 4.

Installations shall be held at the December meeting.

Section 5.

A term shall be for one year.

Section 6.

The Trustees shall be appointed by the PTHC President in the following manner: (4) Four Trustees will be appointed for a (2) Two year term each.

Section 7.

Retiring members shall turn over to their successors all records pertaining to their office at the annual meeting.

Section 8.

Vacancies in elected offices shall be filled by the Executive Board, with the exception of the President and Vice President.

(Section 9 below was modified by membership vote on 09-18-91 to allow dealers to hold office)

Section 9.

Dealers handling treasure hunting equipment, or their employees may not hold the top four offices as President, etc., but may hold office as a Trustee or Sergeant At Arms. (AS MODIFIED)

Dealers handling treasure hunting equipment may hold any office in the club.
